Post operative instructions for Blepharoplasty

- 1. Do not drive a car, operate machinery or make important legal decisions for 24 hours after your surgery, since your judgment may be impaired.
- 2. Drink plenty of liquids in the next 48 hours. You may resume your normal diet as tolerated. Adding additional protein will help during the healing process.
- 3. Take medications as directed.
- 4. Keep cool packs on your eyelids for the first twenty-four hours after surgery.
- 5. Do not rub your eyes.
- 6. Do not bend, strain, lift or exercise for at least one week, or until Dr. Mucci tells you it is okay.
- 7. Sleep with your head elevated with two pillows for a few days after surgery.
- 8. Makeup may be used to hide bruising two weeks after the surgery.
- 9. You may shower the next day, please be careful around incisions and avoid anything harsh around the area.
- 10. If you experience excessive pain, bleeding, swelling or a temperature greater than 100.5 degrees, please contact our office.
